Politics and The American Legion

While neither the post nor it's officers have any intention of telling you HOW to vote, we would like stress how important it is that you DO vote. Voting is one of the key rights, and also one of the big responsibilities, of living in a free republic, so please participate responsibly.

Know the candidates and the issues that will be on the ballot in a few days. South Dakota has **fifteen (15)** non-candidate questions to consider this year, between Constitutional Amendments, Initiated Measures, and Referred Laws - one of which is 80 pages of legalese.

Pundits will try to reduce this complexity down to 15 second sound bytes on TV and radio adds, but please try to read a summary of both sides' arguments, at your own pace, before the election.
