Note on membership renewal notices

July starts a new membership drive for The American Legion, and is often referred to as the start of a "new membership year" as a result. Membership renewal letters will soon start showing up in your mail boxes, and this can often cause concern, particularly for new members who may have just joined as little as a week before.

Membership in The American Legion is based on a calendar year, from Jan 1st to Dec 31st. If you are a 2017 member (as shown on your membership card) it does not matter when you paid your dues (whether joining or renewing) - your membership is good through midnight of December 31st, 2017.

Dues renewal notices, however, will start to be sent out by National Headquarters now, because of the need to process mailings for all 1.8 million current members of the national organization.

These notices will be for 2018 membership, which will start January first of next year, and your membership renewal will not be late (nor will your membership expire) as long as you get it sent in by the end of December.

The post does, however, appreciate it if you can send your renewal in early! There is a lot of paperwork that goes with processing memberships, and being able to spread it out over several months is helpful, as opposed to trying to process all of them in the last few weeks of the year. It also allows us to see how our membership is doing, and if we need to organize a membership events, or have gogetters stop out at people's houses to collect the dues.
