Remember to Vote!

Tuesday, Nov 6th is election day in South Dakota, your chance to execute one of your most fundamental American liberties. Educate yourself on the candidates, referendums, initiated measures, and proposed amendments to the State Constitution, so that you may make an informed choice at the ballot box - wherever you reside.

South Dakota has three constitutional amendments (W, X, and Z), and two initiated measures (24, and 25), on the 2018 ballot, covering campaign finance laws, constitutional limits on future initiatives and referendums, post secondary technical education funding, changing the way future constitutional amendments may be submitted, and increasing the percentage of votes required to pass future constitutional amendments.
