There is an important change to membership in The American Legion; Congress, which controls our eligibility dates, has recently passed the LEGION Act.

This bill states that anybody is eligible for membership in The American Legion if they served at least one day on active duty, at any time from Dec 7, 1941 through a future date to be determined.

This means that anybody who has served, including being at Basic Training, in the US military is now eligible to be a Legion Member.

If you know someone who served, but wasn't able to join in the past, let them know, and get them signed up!

We just started going again on Monster Burgers, so come out and join us. Whether helping in the kitchen, or just stopping in for a burger yourself, your help is appreciated.

We are looking forward to our annual Turkey Shoot in October. We also have the Early Bird membership dinner in November - so get paid up by then, so you can join us at the meal.

There are some new things coming with the VA, so stay tuned for information there.

Membership Eligibility Changes

The American Legion: Congress has recently passed, and the President signed, the LEGION act, which changes the eligibility for membership in The American Legion by declaring that the US has been in a state of conflict since the attack on Pearl Harbor. This change means that anybody who has served at least one day of active duty - including basic training and some advance schools - at any point since December 7th, 1941 is now eligible for membership in The American Legion. We no longer have "eligibility dates" that need to be meet,

and many veterans who were previously not able to join, now may. Please help spread the word, and if you know of anybody who falls into the newly eligible group of veterans, please ask them to join.

American Legion Auxiliary: The American Legion Auxiliary charter was recently amended to change their membership from "female spouses" of veterans, to ALL spouses. The male spouses of veterans are now able to join the American Legion Auxiliary.
